< 答案例 1 - 12 点 >

The figure of the actual income inequality of France is lower than that of the USA, while the rate of the perceived income inequality is much higher than that of the USA. So I think this fact suggests that French people pay more attention to the income inequality than people in the USA. (53 語)

< 答案例 2 - 12 点 >

The Gini index of the USA is the highest of the seven countries, while the percentage of Americans who perceive income inequality is very low. On the other hand, the index of France is the lowest of the seven, while many French people perceive income inequality. We can say therefore that perceived income inequalities don't necessarily reflect actual income inequalities. (60 語)
