問題 1 · 問題 2 (筆記) **1** 次の英文は、中学生の陽菜 (Hina) が英語の授業で書いた作文である。これを読んで、問い (1)~(9) に答えよ。(20点)

I visited my aunt and uncle's house for three days during summer vacation. They \*raise many \*cows. I wanted to help them by taking care of their cows because I like animals. When I got to their house, my aunt gave me some milk. The milk was warm and \*delicious. "I've never drunk delicious milk like this. Why is it so delicious?" I asked my aunt. She said, "Because it is \*fresh milk. Your uncle has just \*milked the cows. Fresh milk is warm." I was surprised to hear that. Then she asked me, "Why don't you milk the cows with your uncle tomorrow?" I answered, "Sure!" She said, "Let's go to the \*cowshed at six tomorrow morning." I had to get up early the next day, so I ①(go) to bed early that night.

The next morning, when my aunt and I got to the cowshed at six, my uncle was already there. He starts cleaning the cowshed at four every morning. He said, "If we don't clean the cowshed, the cows will become \*stressed and won't make milk." I saw cows for the first time. They were so big! I was surprised. He said, "Now, let's give the cows food. They eat food at the cowshed once in the morning and once in the afternoon every day." The cows looked very happy while they were eating.

After giving the cows food, my uncle showed me how to milk the cows and said, "We milk the cows once in the morning and once in the afternoon. Each cow makes about 30 \*liters of milk every day." Milking the cows looked easy while he was doing it. However, ② . When I was milking the cows, I really understood that milk \*comes from \*living animals. After milking the cows, my uncle took them out of the cowshed. He said to me, "If you want cows to make delicious milk, it is important for cows to eat good food and have time to sleep well and \*relax." In the afternoon, the cows came back to the cowshed and ate food, and then we milked the cows again.

The next morning at four, my aunt, my uncle, and I cleaned the cowshed together. While my aunt was cleaning, she was watching the cows \*carefully. I asked her, "Why are you watching the cows so carefully?" She answered, "Cows can't speak. They can't tell us the things they need, so we need to watch them carefully. We \*check that they aren't sick or \*injured every day. There are 50 cows here. They are all like our children." She smiled.

In the evening, my uncle asked me, "What did you think of taking care of the cows?" I answered, "I enjoyed it very much, but now I am very tired. Getting up early and working every day is hard for you, right?" He said, "We love our cows and we want people to drink our delicious milk every day." He showed me ③a picture and a letter. It was a picture of my aunt and uncle taking care of their cows. "Thank you for your delicious milk" was ④(write) in the letter. I stayed at my aunt and uncle's house for only a few days, but taking care of the cows was very hard for me. Through my three-day experience at their house, I learned that we are able to drink milk because people like my aunt and uncle are working hard every day. When I drink milk, I always think about them. Now when I see food sold at shops, I think about the people working hard to \*produce the food for us.

Haruto: Yes, there were two people who came to Japan to see their friends. Three people came here for their jobs and one of them was like you, Ms. Cox.

Ms. Cox: What do you mean?

Haruto: I mean he is an English teacher.

Ms. Cox: Oh, I see. I like working in Japan as a teacher, so I hope he likes his job, too.

Were there any people who came to Japan to study Japanese like me?

Haruto: Yes, ten people were students studying Japanese in Kyoto. I asked them, "Why did you start studying Japanese?" Five students wanted to work in Japan. Two students wanted to enjoy Japanese culture and the 2 number of students wanted to make Japanese friends. How about you, Olivia?

: Well, the job I want to do in the future is to teach Japanese to people in my country. So I am Olivia studying Japanese hard now.

Haruto: I see. That means we can't find the 3 reason that you have in the chart of the results of the survey.

Ms. Cox: You learned a lot of interesting things through this survey, Haruto. You should talk about this in class.

Haruto: Thank you. I will.
