



Ken: Look at these graphs. Graph A shows that many students say that exercise and sports are important. Do you like sports?

Jane: Yes. I play tennis in the park near my house. Oh, I saw your grandfather there last Saturday. He was also playing tennis with someone. How active!

Ken: He often plays tennis for his health. I didn't know you were a tennis player.

Jane: I joined a tennis club in my town when I was a little girl. Now I play tennis from 10 a.m. to noon only on weekends, and I don't have time for other exercise and sports. Do you play any sports?

Ken: Yes. I practice soccer for two hours after school from Tuesday to Friday as a member of the club. We sometimes have games against other teams on weekends.

Jane: Oh, really? So, in Graph B, you're in this group of boys. Do you want to continue exercise and sports after you graduate from junior high school?

Ken: Of course. Graph C shows that many of the students answer like me. I want to try many different sports in the future for my health.

Jane: Sounds good. For my health, I will find more time for exercise and sports, too.

4 中学生の麻友(Mayu)さんは、芸術鑑賞会で落語を演じるために来校した二人の落語家(rakugo performer)に、学校新聞の記者としてインタビューしました。次の英文は、麻友さんが、落語家の遊楽(Yuraku)さんや丈児(Joji)さんと会話をしている様子や、その後の関連する出来事について描いたものです。これを読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

When Mayu went into a room, there were two rakugo performers sitting in their Japanese clothes. One of them told her, "Hello, I'm Yuraku. This is Joji. He is my follower." Yuraku looked old, and the younger man called Joji had blue eyes. (a) The man told her, "I'm Joji. I came from the U.K. Joji is my name as a rakugo performer. My English name is George." (b) "Joji, George...," Mayu said. Yuraku asked her, "Have you ever watched or listened to rakugo?" (c) She said, "Sorry, I haven't. What is it like?" Yuraku said, "For example, a rakugo performer sits alone on the stage, tells funny stories, and makes "gestures with a "hand towel or a fan, like this." (d) "Wow, that's great!" Mayu said to him with surprise.

Joji said, "I came to Japan ten years ago. I went to a show and listened to Yuraku's rahugo in English then. It was so wonderful that <u>①</u>I decided to be his follower." "Rahugo in English?" Mayu asked Yuraku. He answered, "Yes, sometimes. I want more foreign people to know how interesting rahugo is." Joji said, "I have studied Japanese hard for rahugo, too." Yuraku said, "This man could not speak Japanese at first. When we went to a supermarket, the storekeeper said to us in Japanese, 'Irasshaimase.' Joji asked me, 'What's that word?' I said, 'She welcomes us.' So, when people said, 'Irasshaimase,' he always said to them in English, "Thank you.' You don't have to say it every time, right? They were surprised." Joji said, "What a strange man!" Yuraku told him, "I'm talking about you!" Mayu laughed.

Then, she asked Joji, "Do you enjoy living in Japan?" He said, "Of course. In my country, I heard Japanese people were *shy. But in Japan, there are many people sleeping on the train, and they *lean on someone sitting next to them without greeting. That's interesting." Yuraku said, "But, when the train stops at a station, they say, 'Here! I get off!' And they suddenly stand up, and get off the train, right?" Joji said, "Yes, that's amazing. Maybe they have an *alarm clock in their head."

After Mayu laughed again, she asked them, "Finally, do you have a message to us?" Joji answered, "Japanese culture, like rakugo, is popular around the world, and many foreign people are interested in it. Young Japanese people should also know more about their own culture." Yuraku said, "Sounds nice. (3) I hope they'll be interested in it."

After the interview, the *rakugo* show started in the gym. Joji came up to the stage, sat down, and began to talk in English, "The fruit in Yamagata-ken is great. My favorite is *cherries. I heard a funny story like this. A woman says, 'I sent my son to your store to buy 900 *grams of cherries, but he came back home with only 600 grams. Where are the other 300 grams? He doesn't have them.' The storekeeper answers, 'I'm afraid your son is heavier now because he had them.'" Everyone laughed, and the show continued.
