- [1] These days, many foreign people come to Japan and pay attention to traditional Japanese products. When they see the products, they often say, "They are so ①." Some people are surprised at their beauty and the unique Japanese designs on plates, chopsticks, fans, umbrellas and so on. A foreigner who came to buy lacquer* plates said, "They are wonderful. The colors are simple, only black and red. The designs are really cool, and the plates shine in the light."
- [2] Now, some people use creative ideas to make traditional Japanese products. These products are becoming popular among foreign people. Here is an example. Iron kettles (nanbu tehki)* in Iwate Prefecture are famous as traditional products. Though the traditional color was black, one of the craftspeople* created colorful iron kettles for customers. They were sold well, and now people all over the world can buy red, yellow, green, and white ones, too.
- [3] However, the way to his success was not so easy. Many foreign people knew the value* of his black iron kettles, but they did not buy his products so much. They wanted colorful iron kettles instead of black ones. He was 2 at the idea of using different colors for his iron kettles because he thought they should be black. At first, he was not able to imagine how to make them colorful. His challenge was difficult, but he worked hard and never gave up. Finally, he was successful. He started to sell his colorful products in Europe and America. The colorful iron kettles attracted more foreign people, and they started to buy them.
- [4] Why did he try so hard to create colorful iron kettles? He did it not only for customers but also for himself. He strongly believed that he could protect the tradition by creating new products. He did research on the needs of customers and used it to improve his products. In addition, he kept spreading the information about his new products to more people. Because of these efforts, his products began to attract many people. These people also got interested in his original black iron kettles. They were surprised and moved by the beauty of his original products, too.
- [5] Most Japanese craftspeople are proud of their traditional products. They have done their best to keep their traditions and improve their skills for a long time. They have tried to make their traditional products better for customers. From now, it will be important to be more creative to attract many customers around the world. Let's try to mix the sense of beauty of Japanese people and other people all over the world. Having this global point of view will help us to find new styles for traditional products.

Eric: That's true. Last week, I saw ②an interesting machine at a bakery. I took some different kinds of bread and put them on the table to pay. At the table, there was a machine with a camera. It checked all the bread I put there and showed an image of the bread with each name and price on the screen quickly. Then the clerk told me the total price. I realized the machine helped the clerk. It was also a good system for me. I could check on the screen before I paid.

Saori: That's the system a local company in Hyogo invented. I read about it in a newspaper. Now the system works very well, but it didn't at first. Imagine that there are two pieces of the same kind of bread here. Though there are very small differences between them in shapes and colors, we never think they are different types. However, they were different types of bread to the system, and it made mistakes. People in the company checked each mistake and gave the right information to the system. They kept adding information to reduce the mistakes, and finally they made their system perfect. Now, the system is very helpful in many bakeries, especially when the shops are busy. Some people have also tried to apply* the system in the medical field.*

Eric: The system will be used more in many fields. I believe we will have happy lives with these technologies in the future.

Saori: I think so, too.
