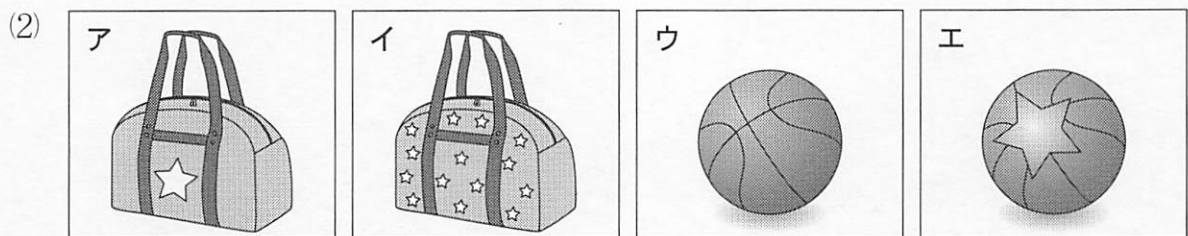
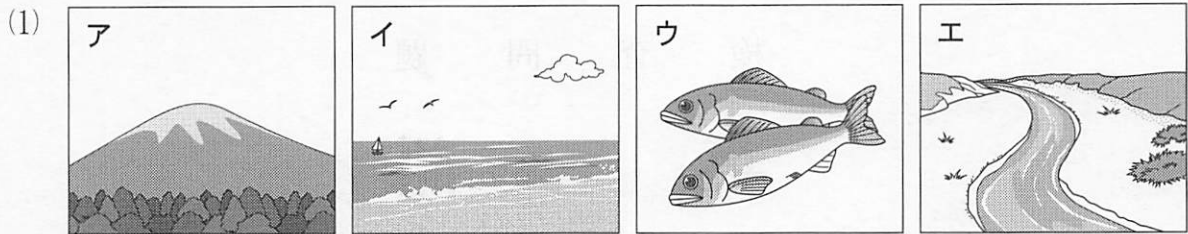

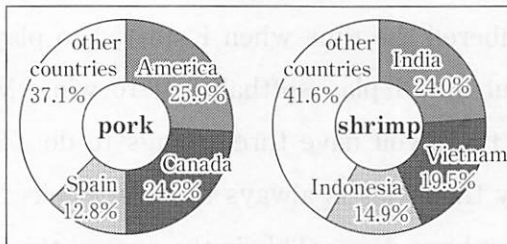
I made *okonomiyaki* with my mother last week. While we were cooking, she said, “Do you think *okonomiyaki* is Japanese food?” I answered, “Of course!” Then she said, “You are right, but some of the ingredients come from other countries. For example, the pork and the shrimps that we’re using now are imported from overseas. We depend on foreign countries for a lot of ingredients.” Then I remembered the word ‘food self-sufficiency rate’. I learned at school that Japan’s food self-sufficiency rate is less than half.

Then, where does the food we eat come from? Look at the two graphs first. You can see that we import pork and shrimps from these countries. The left graph shows that about half of pork is imported from America and Canada. When you look at the right graph, you can see shrimps come from some countries in Asia. I was surprised that we import them from so many different countries.

Now look at the table. This is about the food self-sufficiency rate of four countries in 1963 and 2013. You can see that the food self-sufficiency rate of Canada is the highest both in 1963 and 2013. And in 2013, the rate of France and America is about the same, though the rate of America is higher than the rate of France in 1963. When you compare the rate in 1963 and 2013, only the rate of Japan gets smaller from 1963 to 2013. The table shows that Japan imports about 60% of food from foreign countries in 2013. If we cannot import any food, we may have a difficult time.

I thought *okonomiyaki* was ‘Japanese’ food. But you can also say it is ‘(①)’ food. I guess there are many other things we import. So when you go to a supermarket next time, why don’t you check where they come from?

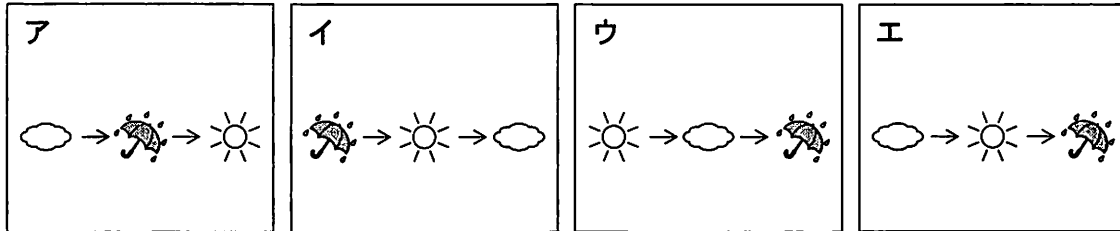
