Mr. Smith: After I returned to America, I really wanted to make bamboo products in the future. So when I \*graduated from college, I decided to go to Oita. Emi: Your story gave us a good chance to think about jobs. Thank you very much for today.


Mr. Smith: You're welcome. See you again.

This summer I visited the \*community center in our town with my grandfather and found some old pictures of a festival. In the pictures, many people were dancing and looked happy. My grandfather said to me, "These are the pictures of the traditional dance in the festival of our town. The dance was very popular and important for the local people in the past. But the dance has not been performed for a long time." When he finished talking about the festival, he looked sad. Then I wanted to perform the dance to make him happy.


