



## 【優斗さんのスピーチ】

Do you know the plants called reeds? They are called *Yoshi* in Japanese. They grow in water and on land. We can see them around Lake Biwa. As the season changes, we can see green reeds in summer and brown ones in winter. These reeds and Lake Biwa together provide beautiful scenery. Today, I would like to share what I have learned about these plants, and tell



you that we have to protect the natural beauty of Lake Biwa together.

First, let me tell you the history of our relationship with reeds.  $< \bar{\infty} >$  In the past, people used reeds in many ways in their daily lives.  $< \iota \iota >$  Also, products like *sudare* and *shoji* made with reeds were very popular especially in summer. However, plastic products became common, and also cheaper products began to be imported. [ ① ], the use of reeds from Lake Biwa decreased. In 1992, Shiga made some rules to encourage people to think of effective ways to use reeds. Today, we see various new products such as towels made from reeds.  $<\bar{\triangleright}>$  Some people have even made recipes for reed cookies!  $<\bar{\lambda}>$ 

In January, I joined a volunteer activity to take care of reeds. There were many people in my group. When I arrived at Lake Biwa, I was surprised to find that the reeds were very tall. First, Mr. Inoue, the group leader, gave us some information about reeds. He told us that cutting reeds in winter is necessary because it helps new reeds grow in the field in spring. He also told us that reeds purify the water. Then, we started cutting reeds. There were so many of them that it took us a long time to finish ②the work. After that, we gathered them and made them dry. It was not an easy task, but I felt good after working hard.

At the end of the activity, Mr. Inoue played the flute made of reeds for us. The sound was beautiful. I enjoyed the music very much. He also gave us a piece of paper made from reeds as a gift and told us that we need to understand the value of Lake Biwa and nature. This piece of paper reminds me of his message.

Thanks to people like Mr. Inoue, the natural beauty of Lake Biwa is protected. If no one took care of the reeds today, [ ③ ] such beautiful scenery. I would like to join the activity again next year. I hope more people will work together to pass on this beautiful lake to the future generations.
