問題1・問題2 (筆記)

1 次の英文は、高校生の俊(Shun)が行ったスピーチである。これを読んで、問い(1)~(8)に答えよ。(20点)

"How beautiful! I love them all." I was really excited when I ①(see) the beautiful *sweets in a shop near my house for the first time. After that, I often visit the shop and enjoy looking at the sweets or buying some of them.

Many people like eating sweets. For example, they eat them on their birthday or other special days to share the good time with their family or friends. I eat sweets when I feel tired or a little sad. Then, I get energy and become happy. In the future, I want 2[(7) with / (1) many people / (2) to / (1) happy and excited / (2) make the sweets that I make. My dream is to become a *pâtissier.

One day, a pâtissier working in the shop which I often visit told me an interesting story. It was about a sweet ③(name) *Tarte Tatin from France. It is a kind of apple pie. Tarte means pie in English, and Tatin is the family name of two sisters who *ran a hotel in the nineteenth century. *According to the pâtissier, Tarte Tatin was made by the sisters *by mistake. One day, one of them tried to *bake an apple pie which they usually made. She had to bake a pie with apple pieces on it to make that apple pie, but she began to bake only the apple pieces without the pie. Then the other sister put the pie on the apple pieces and baked them together. They *turned it upside down and *served it. This was not the right way to make the apple pie they usually made, but ④ Later, it was called Tarte Tatin. People in that town still love Tarte Tatin and they *are proud of it. They enjoy eating it as a traditional sweet in the Tarte Tatin festival in their town every year.

When I heard this story, I was really excited. I sometimes eat *Tarte Tatin*, but this was the first time to hear its story. Each sweet we eat may have an interesting story like *Tarte Tatin*, and we often learn how it was made from its story. I became interested in that and wanted to find another story about popular sweets. Then, I found <u>Some</u> about a Japanese sweet.

In Japan, we have a wagashi called <u>Minazuki</u>, and many people, especially in Kyoto, eat it in June. It is a *triangle and we often see white ones. I didn't know why people eat it in that month. I asked my grandmother and she told me about it. According to her, a long time ago, Minazuki was the traditional name of the sixth month of the year, and it was a part of the hottest season. *Noble people in Kyoto ate *ice in that month because they wanted to feel cool during the hot days. People in the town wanted to do this, but it was very difficult for them to get ice. So they made a sweet which looked like a piece of ice, and ate it. Now, we call it Minazuki. I liked this story when I heard it. My grandmother said that people in Kyoto have eaten it for a long time because they have wanted good health during the hot season. I'm sure that people in Kyoto now are proud of Minazuki as a part of their *culture.

Now, I know that there are sweets made by mistake like *Tarte Tatin*. Also I know there are sweets made from people's wishes like *Minazuki*. I am sure that each sweet has its own story, and I think that the story usually comes from people's lives. I enjoy looking at beautiful sweets, and become more interested in making sweets because of their stories. If I can tell the stories about sweets I make in the future, people will be interested in them and enjoy eating them. They will remember the stories about the sweets and think about someone who made them or ate them a long time ago. I'm sure that will be an exciting and special experience for them. I want to be a *pâtissier* who will give such an experience to many people. I learned that people have told stories about sweets in their culture for a long time. I will *respect their culture and learn more about such stories.
