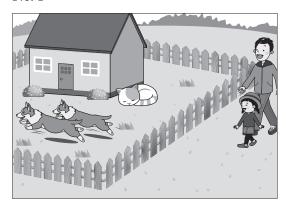

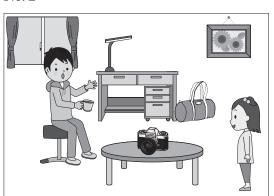

We have a school festival every year. The festival has a contest. In the contest, students make lunch. There are four teams in the contest. Each team uses food from Wakayama. The team which makes the best lunch wins the contest.

We had the festival last week. My friends and I wanted to make the best lunch in the contest. We were the members of Team 1. We made *ume* hamburgers. Team 2 made peach pizza. Team 3 made persimmon sandwiches. Team 4 made orange curry.

Five judges decided the points of originality, appearance, and taste. The audience voted for their favorite lunch and decided the points of popularity. We got 25 points in popularity.

During the contest, a lot of people came to eat our lunch. Our team worked very hard to win the contest, but the winner was Team 3. We were second. In both originality and taste, persimmon sandwiches got more points than *ume* hamburgers. In originality, three teams got the same points. In appearance, persimmon sandwiches and *ume* hamburgers got the same points. When we saw the results, we were sad. We couldn't win the contest.

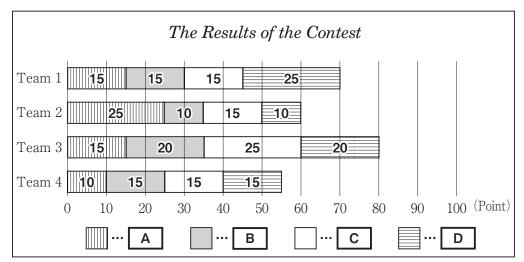

Hello. Today, I'll talk about my experience with people from foreign countries.

Last fall, I saw foreign people at a station. They were trying to buy train tickets. But they didn't know where to buy the tickets. Though I wanted to help them, I couldn't talk to them. I had no courage. I was sad.

At home, I told my father about it. He said, "When you find foreign people in need, you should talk to them. That will help them. I know you often help Japanese people. You should help not only Japanese people but also foreign people by talking to them."

A few days later, I saw a young foreign man in front of my house. His name was Robert. He was looking at a map alone on his bike. I remembered my father's words. I thought, "He may be lost. I should talk to him."

I said to him, "Hello. Can I help you?" in English. Robert said, "Hello. I'm a tourist. I'm from Australia." He began to talk about his situation. He said, "I bought a bike in Wakayama.
