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

問題B これから放送する英文は、英語の授業で、先生がクラスの生徒に対して話したときのものです。先生の質問に対して、あなたならどのように答えますか。 あなたの答えを英文で書きなさい。なお、2文以上になっても構いません。 [2] 次の会話は、日本の高校生の雄太と彩花が、オーストラリアの高校生のスチュワードとジェシーと、テレビ会議システムを使って海洋ごみ問題について話し合ったときのものです。また、グラフ1は、そのとき雄太たちが用いた資料の一部です。これらに関して、あとの1~5に答えなさい。

Yuta : Now, let's talk about the problems of marine debris in Australia and Japan. Our town had a beautiful beach, but now we see a lot of debris there. How about your town?

Steward: Our beach has a lot of debris, too. In Australia, about 75% of debris along the coast is plastic products.

Ayaka : Well, Graph 1 shows that A % of debris along the coast is plastic products in Japan.

Jessie : Some people say that there will be more plastic debris than fish in the sea by 2050.

Yuta: Really? There are so many plastic products in our lives. For example, we use plastic bottles, containers for food, and bags. They are used only once and thrown away.

Then, some plastic products go into the sea.

Steward: That's right. Those plastic products stay in the sea for a long time and break into pieces. Some people try to collect them, but some of them are B small to collect.

Jessie : I also heard they can go into and stay in the bodies of fish and other marine animals.

If we eat these fish, we may have health problems.

Ayaka : Then, what should we do to reduce plastic debris?

Yuta : 48.1% of plastic debris along the coast is plastic bottles, so let's think about them.

We should find some ways to reduce the number of plastic bottles which go into the sea.

Jessie : C . If people recycle plastic bottles, they will not go into the sea.

Then, we will not see any debris on our beaches.

Steward: But some people don't recycle. They just throw away plastic bottles after they drink water or juice. They don't understand the problems of marine debris, so recycling is not enough to reduce the number of plastic bottles.

Ayaka : I have found an interesting idea on the Internet. Some companies have started choosing eco-friendly products instead of plastic bottles. For example, in England, a company sells water in small containers which are made from seaweed.

Steward: That's a nice idea. In our country, a town became famous because every store stopped selling water in plastic bottles. I think it's a good idea. What do you think?

Ayaka : I think we should do the same thing in our town.


Jessie : I think there will be some problems if you do this at every store. We can find another

I came to Japan 32 years ago because I wanted to study Japanese at university. One day, my friend invited me to a Japanese music concert. I was moved by the sound of the biwa, a traditional Japanese musical instrument, and decided to take lessons. The biwa looks like a guitar. I often played the guitar, so I thought it would be easy to play the biwa. However, I had to learn many things. While we are playing the biwa, we often sing. So I had to learn how to sing in Japanese, too.

The lyrics are old Japanese stories. It was very difficult for me to understand the situations and characters' feelings in each story. My master taught me the *biwa* again and again. It was fun to learn the *biwa* and I practiced hard every day.

Three years later, I asked my master, "Can I have a concert with you this year?" She answered, "No, you can't." I asked, "Why?" She answered, "Now, you have a good technique as a musician, but what do you want to tell people through music?" I didn't understand her words.

After that, I visited many places in Japan and talked with many people. Thanks to these experiences, I learned about Japanese history, culture and how people think. Then, I could understand the situations and characters' feelings in each story. After 24 years of learning the biwa, I finally understood the words my master said. One day, she said, "You have become a better musician. Now it's time to create your own music." Through my music, I want people to feel that life is wonderful.

[Akiko]

When Daniel first took my lesson, he spoke Japanese only a little, and I spoke English only a little. It was very difficult for me to teach him the biwa.

However, he practiced very hard. I showed him the lyrics in simple Japanese and told him the meanings of the lyrics with my Japanese students who could speak English. I also taught him how Japanese people feel and behave because I wanted him to learn about Japanese culture. He soon started playing



and singing well. However, I didn't think that he really understood the meanings of the lyrics. So when he asked me to have a ______ together, I answered, "No, you can't." I thought he needed more time to become a better musician. It was necessary for him to express the messages

of the music. The biwa is always connected with people's lives and culture. When he understood that, he became a better musician. While I taught him, I began to understand that Japanese culture is not only for Japanese people.

Now, many Japanese people and people from abroad come to his concerts. I am very happy about it. I think Daniel tells people about Japanese culture and also creates his own music through the *biwa*.
