

Her father loved the pictures she took, and he often said to her, "L words helped her realize the power of pictures. And she wondered how she could be helpful to other people through pictures. Every weekend, she visits sightseeing spots in her town to meet many tourists and takes their pictures for them with their cameras. Before taking pictures of them, she always has time to talk with them and tries to bring smiles to their faces. She believes that is necessary for good pictures. And she hopes that each picture she takes will help the tourists remember their good time in her town. (B)She also wants them to [ her town. Actually, she often gets e-mails from many tourists she met. And they say that they will visit her town again to know more about it. She is very glad about that. [3] The next one is from Daisuke. He is seventeen years old. He learned on the Internet that some old people don't have opportunities to interact with young people. So he decided to join a volunteer activity in a nursing home and do something for such people. Now he is loved by the old people there. First, he has time to talk and do light exercise with them, and then he makes matcha for them. He is in the tea ceremony club of his high school. One old woman in the nursing home has many years of experience in tea ceremony. [ 1 ] Her name is Ms. Tanaka. She gives him good advice. When he visits the nursing home, he always enjoys her some questions about tea ceremony. He says that volunteer activities there help him grow.  $\boxed{4}$  The last one is from Saki. She is twenty-two years old. Every summer, she takes children to an island as a volunteer staff member and lets them have fun with outdoor activities. She didn't need so much time before deciding to join this volunteer activity. She has two different reasons for that. First, she loves interacting with children. She always feels happy when they show her their smiles. [ ゥ] She is shy, and she sometimes cannot speak well in public. She hopes that she will be a different person through volunteer activities. On the island, children have a good time through swimming in the sea and hiking in the mountain. Many islands [ from the mountain are so beautiful. The children have to do their own things because they cannot come to the island with their families. She has (E)her own way when she interacts with the children. If trouble happens, she tells them to talk with each other before giving them advice. She wants them to learn how they can be helpful to other people. She realizes that something in herself is now changing.
- What do you think about these stories? We can have many life-enhancing experiences through volunteer activities. My mother often says, "Helping other people means helping yourself." That is so true. [ I And I believe that volunteer activities will help us make a better future for everyone. I hope that many people will be more interested in volunteer activities.
