



Before I came here, I didn't enjoy talking with others, but now I enjoy talking with my friends on this island. I often asked for help from others\*, but now I don't do that.

I have to leave here soon. I have learned a lot from my experiences here. I think I am independent\* now. Thank you, everyone. I'll never forget the life on this island.

What is the most important thing when we raise\* cows? "The answer is to keep them healthy\*," Jiro's teacher said. "No one wants sick cows. So, we take care of the cows every day. We can use computer technology\* to keep them healthy. It is very useful."

Jiro answered the same question, "I agree with my teacher. It's not easy to keep them healthy. Cows must eat and sleep well. So, we give them good food. We also walk\* them every day. We make beds for cows. Many people think love is important to raise good cows. That's true, but it is not enough for their health."

Now, Jiro and his classmates are working hard to keep their cows healthy. "We will do our best," Jiro and his classmates said.

Hello everyone. Do you like birds? I love birds so much. Today, I'd like to talk about birds and their favorite places, wetlands.

①Today, I will talk about four points. First, I want to talk about birds in Japan. Second, I will explain favorite places of birds. Third, I will tell you ②the problem about their favorite places, and then, I will explain why wetlands are important for us, too.

Do you know how many kinds of birds there are in Japan? Bird lovers in Japan work together to learn about birds every year. From 2016 to 2020, 379 kinds of birds were found. 3 Please look at this graph\*. The three birds seen often in Japan are *Hiyodori*, *Uguisu*, and *Suzume*. We have seen *Hiyodori* the most often. From 1997 to 2002, we could see *Suzume* more often than *Uguisu*, but *Suzume* became the third from 2016 to 2020.

Second, I will talk about birds' favorite places, "wetlands." Have you ever heard about wetlands? Wetlands are areas\* of land\* which are covered with water. Why do birds love wetlands?

Wetlands can give the best environment for many kinds of living things. There is a lot of water in wetlands. So, many kinds of plants live there. These plants are home and food for many insects\* and fish. Birds eat those plants, insects, and fish. Wetlands are the best environment for birds because there is a lot of ( 4 ) for birds.


Wetlands are now getting smaller and that's a big problem. You can find information on the website of the United Nations\*. It says, "In just 50 years—since 1970—35% of the world's wetlands have been lost." Why are they getting smaller? Each wetland has different reasons for this. People are using too much (⑤). For example, they use it for drinking, agriculture\* and industry\*. Global warming\* is hurting wetlands, too. Wetlands are lost faster than forests because of these reasons. This is very serious for birds.

Do we have to solve this? Yes, we do. Those birds' favorite places are very important for humans, too. They support both our lives and environment. I'll tell you <u>6 two things that wetlands do for us.</u> First, wetlands make water clean. After the rain, water stays in wetlands. Then, dirt\* in the water goes down, and the clean water goes into the river. We use that clean water in our comfortable lives. Second, wetlands can hold CO<sub>2</sub>. Plants there keep CO<sub>2</sub> in their bodies even after they die. Actually, wetlands are better at holding CO<sub>2</sub> than forests. They are very useful to stop global warming.








