



Natasha: It means that you should always be \*3 positive.

There are a lot of positive \*4 images about the rainbow.

Sakina: Yes! I have just \*5 searched rainbows on the internet, and I found so many other positive ideas about them! Some people say, "You are my rainbow on a cloudy day," to people they love.

Natasha: That's so cute. I want to be someone's rainbow on a cloudy day. Then, I can make them happy when they are sad. (1)

Sakina: Me, too. Oh, I also like this idea, "Your true colors are beautiful like a rainbow." I think it means that everyone is different and special.

Natasha: Many people feel happy when they think of a rainbow. (ウ)

Sakina: Hmm, let me see. This \*6 article is talking about how many colors are in a rainbow. It's interesting!

Natasha, you are from America, right? How many colors do you see in a rainbow?

Natasha: Let me count. Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Purple. Why do you ask? Is it different for you?

Sakina: Yes! In Japan, we see one more color than you do! This article says that different cultures see different numbers of colors in the rainbow. Wow, in some countries, such as \*7 Indonesia, people see only four colors, and some people in Africa see eight colors! (I)

Natasha: I didn't know that! It's very interesting. Do we learn that when we are children?

Sakina: Yes. The article says every culture teaches different ideas about rainbows.



Here are some ideas for choosing a book:

### 1. Choose a book on your interests

You can choose a book on your \*2 interests. For example, if you are interested in space, you may want to choose a book about space or an astronaut's \*3 biography. Also, if you like traveling, you can read an adventure book. It is easy for you to find something new from that kind of book. You can really enjoy reading it until the end. In your book review, you can write (②).

# 2. Choose a book that has an \*4 attractive main character

It is good to choose a book that has an attractive main character. If you can \*5 sympathize with the main character in the story, the book is easy to read. It would be easy for you to include your own experiences in your book review.

#### 3. Choose a book that was made into a movie

You can choose a book that was made into a movie. Do you really like reading books? If not, watch the movie first and understand the story. Then read the book. When a book is made into a movie, the story sometimes changes. If you find any changes, you can write about the differences between the book and the movie in your book review.

"Eating is \*6 nutrition for your body. Reading is nutrition for your mind." Grow your \*7 knowledge by reading many books. You can find many interesting books in our school library. I look forward to reading your book reviews!
