Did you have breakfast this morning? I know breakfast is important. When I thought about what to talk about in this English class, I remembered a day two weeks ago. On that day, I *overslept and had no time to eat breakfast. Then, I couldn't study very well and got tired quickly at school. So I wanted to learn more about breakfast. Today, I would like to talk about the good points of breakfast and easy ways to have breakfast during busy mornings.

I want to show that breakfast is important for us. In a book, it says that breakfast has two good points. First, breakfast is good for our bodies. Bodies get warmer by having breakfast, and we can play sports well without *getting injured.

I will tell you wonderful news as the second point. If you have breakfast every day, you may get higher test *scores. The *graph of "Having Breakfast and the *Average Correct Answer Rate of a Test" on the Internet says that the Average Correct Answer Rate on the Japanese of students having breakfast is the highest of the six. On all the three subjects, the Average Correct Answer Rate of students who have breakfast is higher than the Average Correct Answer Rate of students who don't have breakfast. The *difference on the Math between the Average Correct Answer Rate of students who don't have breakfast is the biggest of the three subjects. So this graph shows that students having breakfast every day may get higher scores. But be careful because only having breakfast is not enough. Of course, you should study hard, too.

Though we know the good points of breakfast, some of us often *skip breakfast. Now, I will tell you how you can make and have breakfast every day. When you make dinner, it is good to make more food for breakfast. If you do so, you can easily eat it in the morning.

Then, what should we have for breakfast? I think a Japanese traditional breakfast such as rice, miso soup, *natto* and fish is the best. It takes a little long time to cook it, but I don't get hungry for a long time when I eat it for breakfast.

I will be glad if you can now understand that breakfast is important. Of course, not only breakfast but also lunch and dinner are important, too. So when you have *meals, say "thank you" for everything. We have wonderful *phrases in Japanese to show our *gratitude: "itadakimasu" and "gochisosama."


