A man who worked at a bakery sent fresh bread to people who suffered from the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake.\* A lady said, “I’m glad I can eat your soft and delicious bread. It is hard for me to eat hardtack.\* Unfortunately, because of the expiration date\*, we can only enjoy your bread for a short time.” He thought, “What should I do to ①?” It was a very difficult question. However, he thought that helping many people in need with his bread was an important job for him. He did more than 100 experiments and finally he made soft and delicious canned bread.\*

The special canned bread was created from his many efforts, but it was difficult to sell it at the beginning. At that time, many people didn’t know about canned bread. “What should I do to ②?”, he thought. So, he gave 500 cans of bread to the local government. A TV program introduced his special bread and many schools, companies, and local organizations ordered it.

One day, a city hall that bought many cans of bread before called him. The staff in the city hall said, “We’ll buy new cans of bread, so could you throw away the old ones?” He was sad to hear these words. The expiration date of the canned bread was three years. If customers didn’t eat it before the date, they needed to throw it away. He thought, “What should I do to ③?” He faced another problem, but he never gave up. At that time, there was a big earthquake overseas, and he was asked to send the canned bread which he couldn’t sell. Then, he got an idea. He thought, “In the world, there are many people who suffer from disasters and food shortages.\* If I collect canned bread from customers before the expiration date and send it to people in need, the bread will help them.”

He started ④a new service. In this service, people who buy the canned bread receive an email from the bakery before the bread’s expiration date. They can ask the bakery to collect the old bread or they can keep it for an emergency. If they ask the bakery to collect the old bread, they can buy new bread with a discount. After the bakery checks the collected bread’s safety, it is sent to people who suffer from disasters or food shortages. With this service, more than 200,000 cans of bread were sent around the world.

At the beginning of his challenge, his goal was to keep bread soft and delicious for a long time. After he achieved his goal, he still faced other problems. However, he kept trying different ways to solve these problems. As a result, he could make a system which helped many people. “I always kept ⑤my mission in my mind. That was the most important thing for the success of my mission.”, he said.

Some people came to our shopping area to get such things though it was far from their houses. We think we'll get more visitors if they can get information about the unique things in our town more easily. So, we suggest ②two things. One idea is to create a website about the shopping area. This will introduce a variety of original things sold there. Also, we should make the website in English for foreigners living in our town and people from foreign countries. The other idea is that we should plan activities which visitors can enjoy in the shopping area. For example, visitors can enjoy making original bags from our traditional cloths. In our presentation, we'll suggest how to ③. In our local area, the number of farmers is decreasing because farming is hard work. We also hear that fewer people are interested in agriculture. In our town, some companies develop machines with the latest technology for agriculture. We can borrow these machines for the event. If people try these machines, they'll realize that the machines can reduce the hard work of farming. Thanks to such machines, farmers can grow their vegetables without chemicals. At the event, we'll cook these vegetables and serve them to the visitors. The other idea is that we make posters with information about our local vegetables and the farmers who grow them. Visitors to our local area don't know much about our local vegetables. We'll also put some recipes on the poster. These recipes will give some ideas of dishes that use our local vegetables to people visiting our local area. They'll notice that eating more local vegetables will support local farmers. Because of these ideas, the visitors will be more interested in our local agriculture. We expect that more people will support our local farming.
