What is happening to animals? According to the *Red Data Book, it is more difficult to find some kinds of animals. In the future, we cannot find these animals anymore.

Why is this situation happening? First, people sometimes bring animals that don't usually live in the places. Those strange animals begin to live there. Second, people change the *habitats of animals by making *roads or houses.

Why is this situation a problem? When these things happen, the animals have to leave their own places. If such animals *disappear, the animals that eat them cannot find their food. So the *ecosystem will be changed.

How can we solve the problem? First of all, it is important to improve the lives of those animals. We have to make better habitats for animals, such as forests, rivers or seas.
