





I practiced with Ken. He hit a ball to me \*slowly, but I couldn't \*return the ball. I tried it many times and did my best, but hitting the ball back to him was difficult for me.

When the P.E. class finished, I said to Ken, "I'm sorry. You couldn't practice tennis enough today because A." He said, "Don't worry about that. Everyone is a beginner at first. Instead, enjoy trying something new!" His words gave me power to try tennis again.

In the next P.E. class, I decided to be positive. I asked Ken and the other classmates why I couldn't hit balls well, and we tried various practices together. Finally, at the end of the class,
