





When you were in elementary school, what was the color of your school backpack?

Graph A shows the colors of school backpacks used about 30 years ago. We can see that

Next, Graph B shows the colors of school backpacks bought in 2023. Black was still the most common. However, look at red. It occupied 43 percent about 30 years ago, but in 2023, (B)

. Then, what colors of school backpacks were bought more? Purple, pink, sky blue, and navy blue! Besides, "others" occupied more than a quarter! That's really interesting, right?

From the graphs, we can learn that school backpacks today have a larger variety of colors. That means children today have more options for the colors of their school backpacks! I wonder what colors children will choose in the future!

She enjoyed it together with them. When she finished reading it, a girl came to her and said, "I liked this story. See you." Mizuki was happy to hear that.
