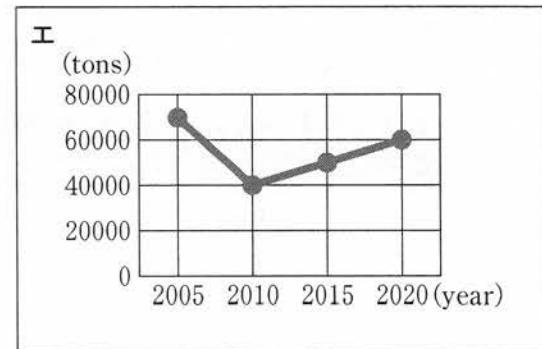



Dictionaries are very helpful tools that show you the meaning of words that you do not know. Many of you probably use electronic dictionaries, but paper dictionaries are still popular among people studying languages.

Sometimes, dictionaries must be revised. When a dictionary is revised, many new words are added to it and also some old words are deleted from it. There are usually more new words than old words. As a result, the revised paper dictionary becomes thicker than the old one.

In 2014, when an English-Japanese paper dictionary was revised, the new dictionary had 5,000 new words and 200 more pages were added. [ア] However, surprisingly, the new dictionary was as thick as the old one. What kind of new techniques were used to make the new dictionary?

If you want to make a book really thin, one way is to make the words on each page smaller, or the spaces between the words smaller. [イ] However, if the word size and the spaces between the words in the dictionary are smaller, they cannot be printed clearly or be read easily.

Another way is to make each piece of paper thinner. If you made a dictionary with the paper which your school teachers give you during class, it could become really thick and hard to use. However, if you use thinner paper, it is possible for words to show through. [ウ] So, dictionary companies tried to produce better paper many times and finally invented thin paper which does not show through.

When you look for a word in your dictionary, you have to turn many pages, so the pages cannot be too stiff. Also, if the pages of the dictionary are too stiff, it closes on its own and it is not helpful for people when they study with it. Companies have tried to make dictionaries thin and light and also useful for studying. One company solved the problem with a new technique. Now, when you turn the page, the paper is soft enough that the pages turn easily and two pages or more are never turned at the same time. [エ]

In this way, you can use a paper dictionary without any problems and learn languages with it well. Many ideas and techniques are included in one paper dictionary. When you use your paper dictionary, please remember this.
